Jake & Elwood's Blues Brothers at downtown Miami concert series on Dec. 9

The DWNTWN Miami Concert Series is bringing a little soul, a little rock, and lots of blues and memories to close the year.

This month's free concert will feature Jake & Elwood's Blues Brothers Revue on Friday, Dec. 9 at 6 p.m. in Bayfront Park.

Jake & Elwood's Blues Brothers Revue is a revival group paying homage to the original blues brother characters Dan Aykroyd and John Belushi famously created in 1978 as part of a musical sketch on Saturday Night Live. The tribute band has performed with the original Blues Brothers Band and are the only ones sanctioned by the Belushi Estate, Dan Aykroyd and Saturday Night Live.

The downtown concert series runs every second Friday of the month from October through April (except March).

Next month's concert will be on Jan. 13. The artists have yet to be announced.

The Miami Downtown Development Authority organizes the monthly events. The DDA is an independent public agency of the City of Miami funded by a property tax paid by residents and businesses within the district's boundaries. Its mission is to improve the economy of downtown Miami through events, marketing and capital improvement projects.
