Architecture Competition

>> This year's DawnTown competition is inviting architects, designers, students and amateurs from around the world to submit creative ideas for a new Metromover station at the north edge of Museum Park next to Biscayne Bay, between the future home of the Miami Art Museum and the Miami Science Museum. The registration deadline is Oct. 14, and materials are due by Oct. 28.

First, second and third place winners will be selected by a panel comprised of Miami Art Museum Director Terry Riley, Miami Science Museum President Gillian Thomas, Rubell Family Collection representative Mera Rubell, Knight Foundation Program Director Dennis Scholl and Miami-Dade Transit Director Harpal Kapoor. Cash prizes of \$8,000, \$4,000 and \$2,000 will be awarded. Sponsored by the Knight Foundation, the Miami Downtown Development Authority, Marquis and Akerman Senterfitt, DawnTown 2009 seeks to bring innovative architecture to Downtown Miami and draw international attention to Miami's urban environment.
